

## IAABO REFRESHER EXAM—2022

The Refresher Exam reflects the National Federation Rules. It includes 75 questions and their answers.

**(“In the act of shooting” on this examination means the ball is still in the player’s hand.)**

| 1. The dribbler has committed a violation if the dribbler steps on a boundary line even though the dribbler is not touching the ball while out of bounds. Is this correct?  | 1.  | Yes | No |
| 2. A-1’s pass accidentally strikes B-2’s leg. The officials rule a violation. Is this correct?  | 2.  | Yes | No |
| 3. A-1 ends the dribble and fumbles the ball. The loose ball touches A-2 and is then recovered by A-1 who begins another dribble. The officials rule this is legal. Is this correct?  | 3.  | Yes | No |
| 4. Rebounder A-2 returns to the court with the ball and excessively swings his elbows without contacting any players. The officials rule this is legal. Is this correct?  | 4.  | Yes | No |
| 5. Religious head coverings are permitted without state association approval provided they are secured properly and are not made of abrasive or hard materials. Is this correct?  | 5.  | Yes | No |
| 6. Hair adornments are permitted provided they are securely fastened close to the head and do not present an increased risk to the player, teammates, or opponents. Is this correct?  | 6.  | Yes | No |
| 7. A-1 attempts a pass to A-2 in Team A’s backcourt. The ball hits Team B’s basket and deflects directly back to A-1 who catches the ball and starts a dribble. The official rules a legal play. Is this correct?   | 7.  | Yes | No |
| 8. After the horn sounds to end the quarter, A-1 and B-1 taunt one another as they head to their respective benches. The official rules a double technical foul for unsporting conduct. The officials notify each coach that they have lost their coaching box privileges and begin the next quarter with the alternating possession throw-in. Is this correct? | 8.  | Yes | No |
| 9. Team A requests and is granted a 60-second timeout. After 15 seconds both teams are ready for play. The officials resume play immediately. Is this correct?  | 9.  | Yes | No |
| 10. Team A is erroneously awarded the ball for an alternating possession throw-in. After the ball is at the disposal of Team A for the throw-in, Team A is granted a time-out. During the time-out it is determined that the ball should have been awarded to Team B. The officials cancel the time-out. Is this correct?                                       | 10. | Yes | No |
| 11. The home (official) scorebook is taken to Team A’s locker room at halftime. The officials assess a technical foul to Team A. Is this correct?   | 11. | Yes | No |
| 12. B-1 obtains legal guarding position near the sideline. B-1 moves laterally and places one foot on the sideline. A-1 contacts B-1 in the torso. The official rules a player control foul on A-1. Is this correct?  | 12. | Yes | No |
| 13. A-3 sets a screen within the visual field of stationary B-1 just short of contact. B-1 turns and makes contact with A-3. The official rules an illegal screen. Is this correct?   | 13. | Yes | No |
| 14. During a designated spot throw-in, thrower A-1 passes the ball to A-2. While out of bounds, A-1 takes several steps laterally and then enters the playing court. Upon entry, A-1 receives a pass from A-2. The official rules a legal play. Is this correct?  | 14. | Yes | No |
| 15. When there is only one player participating for a team, the team shall forfeit the game unless the referee believes that team has an opportunity to win the game. Is this correct?  | 15. | Yes | No |
| 16. The head coach is charged with a direct technical foul for failing to designate the five starting players at least 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time. Is this correct?  | 16. | Yes | No |
| 17. During a designated spot throw-in, the thrower takes three steps backwards prior to releasing the ball. The official rules a throw-in violation. Is this correct?   | 17. | Yes | No |
| 18. As A-1 is dribbling, the official notices that the number on A-1’s uniform is 6. The official stops play and issues a direct technical foul to the head coach. Is this correct?   | 18. | Yes | No |
| 19. Immediately following a goal by Team A, Team B has all five players out-of-bounds. B-1 holds the ball and the other four sprint onto the floor. B-1 completes the throw-in to B-5. The official rules a violation. Is this correct?   | 19. | Yes | No |
| 20. While A-1 is in the act of shooting, B-2 pushes A-2 into A-1. A-1 continues the motion and scores. Team A is in the bonus. Official charges B-2 with a personal foul, counts the goal and awards A-2 a bonus free throw situation. Is this correct?   | 20. | Yes | No |
| 21. While A-1’s try is in flight, a double personal foul is committed. The try is successful. Official awards Team B the ball and rules Team B may move along the end line on the ensuing throw-in. Is this correct?  | 21. | Yes | No |
| 22. Airborne shooter A-1 fouls B-1. A-1’s attempt lodges between the ring and backboard. The possession arrow favors Team A. The officials resume play by awarding the ball to Team A. Is this correct?   | 22. | Yes | No |

23. Yes No 23. A technical foul is charged to Team A's trainer. The official also charges the head coach with an indirect technical foul. Is this correct?
24. Yes No 24. A passed ball touches an official who has one foot out of bounds. The officials allow play to continue. Is this correct?
25. Yes No 25. B-1 intentionally fouls A-1 who is in the act of shooting an unsuccessful three-point try. The official awards A-1 two free throws. Is this correct?
26. Yes No 26. A-1 is intentionally fouled by B-1. Upset with the foul, A-1 pushes B-1 and is assessed a technical foul. The officials rule this is a double foul. Is this correct?
27. Yes No 27. After A-1's successful free throw, A-1 is replaced by A-6. B-1's subsequent throw-in goes untouched out-of-bounds. A-1 reports to re-enter, but is denied by the officials. Is this correct?
28. Yes No 28. During a designated spot throw-in, A-1 drops the ball which rolls several feet away. A-1 leaves the spot, retrieves the ball and completes the throw-in prior to five-seconds expiring. The official rules a legal play. Is this correct?
29. Yes No 29. A-2, located in the frontcourt, deflects A-1's throw-in into the backcourt. A-3 is the first to touch the ball in the backcourt. The official rules a legal play. Is this correct?
30. Yes No 30. A-1's dribble deflects off A-1's leg and is about to go out-of-bounds. A-1 requests and is granted a time-out. Is this correct?
31. Yes No 31. A-1 attempts a three-point try. The ball, on its downward flight, above the ring and with the possibility of entering the basket, is blocked by B-2. The officials award three points to Team A and award Team B a throw-in anywhere along the end line. Is this correct?
32. Yes No 32. During an alternating possession throw-in, A-1 steps onto the court prior to releasing the ball. The official rules a violation and has the scorer set the alternating possession arrow toward Team B's basket. Is this correct?
33. Yes No 33. During a live ball, an assistant coach of Team B is standing within the coaching box giving instructions to Team B players. The officials rule that the assistant coach may stand during a live ball provided he does so from within the coaching box. Is this correct?
34. Yes No 34. The ball becomes live when one of the jumpers taps the tossed ball. Is this correct?
35. Yes No 35. A-1 holds the ball in the lane for two seconds, dribbles for two seconds towards the basket and ends the dribble with one foot out of the lane and the other foot on the free throw line. The officials rule a three-second violation. Is this correct?
36. Yes No 36. After securing a rebound, A-2 excessively swings the arms/elbows and contacts B-2 above the shoulders. The official rules a common foul. Is this correct?
37. Yes No 37. During a throw-in, A-1 throws the ball towards A-1's basket. While the ball is in the cylinder, B-2 touches the ball. The official rules a violation on A-1 for throwing the ball at the basket and ignores B-2's basket interference. Is this correct?
38. Yes No 38. It is legal for A-1, while closely guarded in the frontcourt, to hold the ball for four seconds, dribble the ball for four seconds, and then hold the ball for four seconds. Is this correct?
39. Yes No 39. After a field goal, A-1's throw-in is intentionally kicked by B-1 near the end line. The official awards Team A a designated spot throw-in. Is this correct?
40. Yes No 40. During a throw-in, airborne A-2 catches the pass after jumping from the frontcourt. A-2 lands with one foot in the frontcourt, hesitates and then places the other foot down in the backcourt. The official rules a legal play. Is this correct?
41. Yes No 41. Both teams are in the bonus. While A-1 is dribbling, B-1 tips the ball away. During the scramble for the loose ball, A-1 pushes B-1 and is charged with a common foul. The official awards B-1 a bonus free throw situation. Is this correct?
42. Yes No 42. A-3 dunks during the pregame warm-up. The official charges A-3 with a technical foul, charges the head coach of Team A with an indirect technical foul. The official also informs the coach that the coaching-box privileges have been lost. The official instructs the scorer to record one team foul for Team A. Is this correct?
43. Yes No 43. After a score by Team A, thrower B-1 has the ball when A-3 intentionally fouls B-2 near the end line. The official awards B-2 two free throws and then gives Team B a designated spot throw-in on the end line closest to where the foul occurred. Is this correct?
44. Yes No 44. Both teams are in the bonus. A-1's throw-in from the frontcourt end line is deflected by A-2 into the backcourt. Before B-1 can secure control of the ball, A-2 fouls B-1. The official rules a team control foul on A-2. Is this correct?
45. Yes No 45. A-1's try is unsuccessful. A-2 bats the rebound so that the ball bounces in Team A's frontcourt and continues into the backcourt where it is controlled by A-3. The officials rule a backcourt violation. Is this correct?

46. A-2, in the act of shooting, is fouled by B-2 as the horn sounds to end the quarter. A-2 continues the throwing motion and releases the ball which passes through the basket. The officials disallow the goal and award A-2 two free throws with no players lined up along the lane. Is this correct? 46. Yes No
47. Defensive basket-interference may be ruled on a throw-in. Is this correct? 47. Yes No
48. With four minutes remaining in the quarter, A-1, in the backcourt, throws a pass toward A-5 in the frontcourt. The pass hits the ring and rebounds untouched back to A-1 in the backcourt. The officials allow play to continue. Is this correct? 48. Yes No
49. A-1 loses contact with the ball on an attempted dunk after which A-1's hand contacts the ball within the cylinder. The official rules basket interference. Is this correct? 49. Yes No
50. A missed try by A-1 rebounds toward the free throw semi-circle. A-2 bats the ball away from B-2 toward the division line. A-3 muffs the ball and it goes into the backcourt where it is recovered by A-3. The official rules a backcourt violation. Is this correct? 50. Yes No
51. It appears a fight may break out and A-6 and A-7 enter the playing court. The official charges A-6 and A-7 with flagrant technical fouls and Team A's coach with one indirect technical foul. Team A receives two team fouls. Team B is awarded two free throws and play is resumed by awarding the ball to Team B at the division line. Is this correct? 51. Yes No
52. Airborne A-1 deflects a pass to the floor. A-1 returns to the floor, catches the ball and dribbles. The official rules an illegal dribble. Is this correct? 52. Yes No
53. During A-1's interrupted dribble, a double personal foul is charged. The official awards the ball to Team A out of bounds nearest to where the ball was located at the time of the foul. Is this correct? 53. Yes No
54. Dribbler A-1 is contacted by B-1 after time expires. The official ignores the contact because the contact was neither intentional nor flagrant. Is this correct? 54. Yes No
55. While free thrower A-1 has the ball, A-2 commits a common foul against B-2. The official rules a team control foul. Is this correct? 55. Yes No
56. As the official is ready to place the ball at A-1's disposal for a throw-in, the official notices Team A has six players on the floor. The official assesses Team A with a technical foul. Is this correct? 56. Yes No
57. While A-1's try is in flight, A-2 commits a common foul against B-2. The try is successful. The official cancels the goal and awards the ball to Team B at the spot nearest the foul. Is this correct? 57. Yes No
58. A-1 releases the ball on a try. The ball hits the backboard, is still on its way up and is outside the imaginary cylinder when B-5 traps the ball against the backboard. The official rules goaltending. Is this correct? 58. Yes No
59. B-1 attempts to block A-1's layup attempt, misses the ball and slaps the backboard. The contact causes the backboard to vibrate and the ball rolls off the ring. The official rules basket interference. Is this correct? 59. Yes No
60. B-1 commits a common foul against dribbler A-1. Team A is awarded a throw-in and misses a try for goal. B-5 rebounds the miss and passes to B-1 who scores. The table sounds the horn and play is stopped before the ensuing throw-in starts. The scorer informs the officials that the common foul was the seventh team foul of the half. The officials rule that it is too late to correct the error of not awarding a bonus free throw situation. Is this correct? 60. Yes No
61. With Team B leading 51 to 50, Team A scores with eight seconds left in the game. A-6 and A-7 rush onto the court to congratulate the shooter. This occurs while B-1 is trying to complete a throw-in to B-2. The official rules one technical foul against Team A, awards Team B two free throws and the ball for a division-line throw-in. Is this correct? 61. Yes No
62. A-1's try for goal is prevented as a result of a flagrant foul committed by B-1. A-2 retaliates by shouting obscenities at B-1 and is assessed a technical foul. The officials award A-1 two free throws with no players lined up along the lane. Team B is then awarded two free throws. Play is resumed with a Team B throw-in at the division line opposite the table. Is this correct? 62. Yes No
63. The alternating possession arrow is pointing toward Team A's basket when A-1 is fouled. The scorer indicates that it is Team B's 10th team foul of the half. A-1 misses the first free throw. Prior to the second free throw, the scorer notifies the officials that Team B only has 9 team fouls. The official awards the ball to Team A for a designated spot throw-in on the end line. Is this correct? 63. Yes No
64. The alternating possession arrow is pointing toward Team B's basket when A-1 drives into the lane and collides with B-3 while dribbling the ball. One official signals a blocking foul and the other signals a player control foul. The officials rule a double foul and award the ball to Team A on the end line. Is this correct? 64. Yes No
65. There is one-tenth of a second (0:00.1) remaining on the game clock. During a throw-in from the end-line, A-1 passes the ball to A-5 who catches the ball and then releases it before the horn sounds. The ball passes through the basket. The officials disallow the goal. Is this correct? 65. Yes No

66. Yes No 66. B-1 is directly behind A-1 who receives the ball in the low post. As A-1 turns to try for a goal, B-1's hands and arms extended vertically in a slightly forward position. A-1's arm contacts B-1's arms. The official rules a foul on B-1. Is this correct?
67. Yes No 67. B-1 places both hands on dribbler A-1. The official rules a handchecking foul even though the contact did not affect A-1's freedom of movement. Is this correct?
68. Yes No 68. Team A has no time-outs remaining when A-1 requests a time-out. The official charges Team A with a technical foul, but does not allow Team A to use the time-out. Is this correct?
69. Yes No 69. During A-1's second free throw attempt, A-2 commits a violation by crossing the three-point arc near the free-throw line extended. Team B is awarded the ball on the end line for a designated spot throw-in. Is this correct?
70. Yes No 70. On a designated spot throw-in, thrower A-1 jumps straight up in the air and returns to the floor. A-1 then takes two steps backwards and inbounds the ball. The official rules a throw-in violation. Is this correct?
71. Yes No 71. A-1 is bleeding and is directed to the bench. The coach requests a 30-second time-out to keep A-1 in the game. The official rules a 60-second time-out must be used. Is this correct?
72. Yes No 72. While running to catch a pass, A-1 muffs the ball and takes several steps but catches the ball before it strikes the floor. The official rules a traveling violation. Is this correct?
73. Yes No 73. A-1 attempts a jump shot. While the ball is below the ring inside the basket, A-5 jumps up and touches the net. The official rules this is legal. Is this correct?
74. Yes No 74. A-5's dunk attempt misses and the ball is deflected upward outside the imaginary cylinder. A-5 grabs the ring to protect himself. A-5, while still holding the ring, grabs the ball and dunks it. The official rules this is legal. Is this correct?
75. Yes No 75. During the jump ball, A-5 and B-5 both tap the ball into the air where it is tapped by A-5 again. A-5 then taps the ball once more directing it to A-1. The officials rule this is legal. Is this correct?
